

Call for Minor Research Projects for Faculty Members (2024-25)

Guidelines

Centre for Tribal Studies, University invites applications from young faculty members of the University on any one of the following themes:

- i. Re-writing of Tribal Ethnographies; Restudy of Tribes
- ii. Role of Women in Tribal Societies
- iii. Customary Law and its Interface with State Law
- iv. Traditional Knowledge
- v. Sustainable Practices
- vi. Sacred Spaces & Spirituality
- vii. Ethnoarchaeology and Oral History
- viii. Skills and their Documentation: Interface with the market
- ix. Cultural heritage: Identification and Protection

Research Period: These projects will be awarded for a period of **One / Two** months for Maximum grant up to Rs. 40,000/-. The grant amount will depend on the requirement of the project.

Eligibility: All faculty members of university departments/ colleges/centres under University of Delhi are eligible to apply. However, preference will be given to those young Assistant Professors with good research record on tribes.

Project Proposal: It should clearly mention the objectives, methodology to achieve the stipulated targets. Project proposal should be duly forwarded by the Head/Principal/Director of the Department/College/Centre and must enclose budget breakup in different heads.

The researcher will be responsible for the execution and timely completion of the project.

He/She will also be responsible for the utilization of the grant in the current financial year as per University rules and regulation.

One of the expected outcomes of this project should be quality publication in reputed journals (Scopus, UGC care)

The proposals shall be screened and evaluated by an expert committee and the decision of the CTS will be final and binding.
