Nature of Appointment

- Position: Honorary Adjunct Professor
- Tenure: One Academic Year (likely to be extended)
- Remuneration: The appointment is purely honorary. *No salary, honorarium, or any other financial remuneration shall be payable by the Centre for Tribal Studies, University of Delhi.*

Eligibility

Applicants should:

- Be a serving faculty member of the University of Delhi.
- Possess a distinguished record of teaching, research, and academic contributions, with an interest in the study of tribal communities.
- Demonstrate an interest in interdisciplinary scholarship and institutional development.

Roles and Responsibilities

The Honorary Adjunct Professor shall:

- Provide academic mentorship and strategic guidance to the Centre's teaching, research, publications, seminars, conferences, workshops, and other academic initiatives, while fostering interdisciplinary collaboration within the University of Delhi.
- Actively engage with the Centre's activities by attending at least two academic or outreach events organised by the Centre for Tribal Studies each month during the tenure, contributing to its academic growth through knowledge sharing and intellectual leadership.
- Contribute to strengthening the Centre's academic vision through knowledge sharing and intellectual engagement.

Interested faculty members should submit their application on plain paper through the proper channel, along with a recent Curriculum Vitae (CV) containing a passport-size photograph. The application should reach the Centre for Tribal Studies (CTS) via email at **director@cts.du.ac.in** on or before 31 July 2026.
