Professor Patnaik currently serves as the Director of the Centre for Tribal Studies as well as Head of the Department of Anthropology at the University of Delhi, and President of the Indian Anthropological Association. He also holds the position of Chair for the Commission on Policy and Governance within the International Union of Anthropological and Ethnological Sciences (IUAES). Previously, he held prestigious roles as the Vice Chancellor of Utkal University (2017-2020) and the Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology. With more than two decades of teaching experience in Social Anthropology, Professor Patnaik's career includes serving as a Fulbright-Nehru Visiting Lecturer at the VT Institute for Policy and Governance/Urban Affairs and Planning at Virginia Tech University, USA, from August 2011 to January 2012. He has also been a visiting faculty member at various universities, both within India and internationally, contributing significantly to academic collaboration and exchange. In addition to his academic leadership, Professor Patnaik serves as the Convener of the Research Committee for the Rural, Peasant, and Tribal Commission, and is the Director of Publications for the Ethnographic and Folk Culture Society. His scholarly contributions extend to the editorial realm, where he is a member of the Editorial Board of Asian Anthropology, a journal published by the Hong Kong Anthropological Society. Professor Patnaik also holds governance roles within higher education, acting as the Chairman of the Governing Board of Lakshmibai College, University of Delhi, and as Treasurer and Governing Board Member of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences for Women, University of Delhi. His diverse contributions exemplify a career dedicated to advancing anthropology and fostering cross-disciplinary collaboration on a global scale.
